C5PBA Hall of Fame Policy

Classification of Member's

- Players (bowlers)
- Builders
- Coaches

Eligibility for selection

- Any person who is or has been distinguished as a player, a builder or a coach may be honoured as a member of the C5PBA Hall of Fame.
- Players, coaches and builders may be active or inactive at their time of selection.
- Members of the C5PBA Board of Directors, staff or selection committee are eligible for selection.

Appointment of Selection Committee

- The C5PBA Board of Directors shall appoint a selection committee consisting of 6 current members and/or Board of Directors, who are knowledgeable in the history and traditions and whose prestige, judgment, and integrity are most likely to ensure the fair and impartial assessment of the qualifications of the candidates.
- In the appointment of the committee consideration will be given to ensure the majority of provinces are represented when possible.
- The Chair will be the 1st Vice President of the C5PBA and will have a vote in the selection process.
- Appointments to fill vacancies may be made by the C5PBA Executive.

Basis of Selection

Player

Candidates for selection as a player shall be chosen on the basis of their playing skills, abilities and sportsmanship at the national level.

Builder

- Candidates for selection as a builder shall be chosen on their contribution to the sport of 5 pin bowling. Candidates' contributions will be based on policy and coach development, volunteer efforts and any other significant contributions at the national level that help to build our sport.

Coaches

- Candidates for selection in this category shall be chosen on their coaching abilities and accomplishments at the national level.

Nomination Process

- Each province / territory, through it's provincial body, may make one nomination for each category and each selection must be signed by the provincial / territorial president.
- Each member of the C5PBA Executive and Executive Director may make one nomination for each category.
- All nominations shall be made in writing on the applicable Hall of Fame application form. All nominations must be submitted to the C5PBA office 60 days prior to the AGM.
- Forty-five days prior to the AGM each member of the selection committee will receive a copy of all nominations and supportive documentation. The committee will meet prior to the AGM in order to make their selection. This will then be forwarded to the Executive Committee for ratification.
- Nominations will stay active for 3 years, after which time they can resubmit the nominee. The office will ensure all nominations will stay on file for 3 years.

Method of Election

- Each year 4 bowlers, 2 builders and 1 coach may be inducted into the C5PBA Hall of Fame.
- Nominees will be inducted as part of the Closing Ceremonies at any C5PBA National Championship where possible.
